PUBLIC ASSISTANCE IN KENTUCKY  
FEBRUARY 2020**

Data contained in the PA-264 series of reports reflects statistical tabulations of recipients and payments for the major welfare programs administered by the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, Department for Community Based Services; Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (K-TAP) and State Supplementation to persons who are Aged, Blind or have a Disability.

Data are displayed by county as well as state totals for recipients and payments for each major program. Data pertaining to recipients of money payments are based on actual eligibility for the indicated period. This report does not reflect all fiscal adjustments.

References to “Guardianship Cases” relate to those in which the recipient has been legally adjudged mentally incompetent and the State Agency has been designated as “Guardian” in their behalf. Data contained herein relates to those recipients receiving assistance through a program administered by the agency. Beginning July 1980, responsibility for such “Guardianship” cases was transferred from the respective counties to the Agency’s Central Office in Franklin County even though the recipient was not physically relocated.

Part A: Kentucky Transitional Assistance (K-TAP) Established under Title IV-A of the Social Security Act of 1936, the federal/state funded money payment program provides for the basic subsistence needs of children who are deprived of parental support or care due to death, continued absence, physical or mental incapacity of the parent and unemployment of the primary wage earner in two parent families. In addition, assistance is available for eligible children needing placement in foster care upon judicial finding that the home is not conducive to the child’s wellbeing until the home setting is improved and the child can be returned. On October 1, 1942, Kentucky implemented AFDC for children deprived due to death, absence or incapacity of parents and in April 1982, such foster care children were transferred to the Department for Social Services. The unemployed parents segment (AFDC-UP) became effective in Kentucky October 1990 and is reflected in Part A separate from Basic AFDC. The Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 eliminated entitlement to the Aid to Families with Dependent children (AFDC) program and created the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families block grant program, called Kentucky Transitional Assistance Program (K-TAP) in Kentucky. K-TAP became effective in Kentucky on October 18, 1996 with the approval of the Title IV-A State Plan.

Part B: State Supplementation to persons who are Aged, Blind, or have a Disability (SS) The 1972 Social Security Amendments mandated the Social Security Administration to assume the Title XVI, Aid to Aged, Blind, or Disabled, Federal/State money assistance program. This program as implemented by SSA in January 1974 is known as Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and is supported by all federal monies. The law also mandated states to supplement from all state monies, any difference between a SSI payment and the prior AABD payment for persons who were receiving Title XVI on December 31, 1973; hence, “Mandatory State Supplementation”. Kentucky also elected to provide this same type of state supplementation to those persons becoming eligible for SSI after January 1974 as well as non-SSI recipients meeting the eligibility requirements. Not required by law, this all-state payment is known as “Optional State Supplementation”. In Kentucky, State Supplementation is directed primarily to persons who are aged, blind or have a disability residing in Personal Care Homes, Family Care Homes, or persons needing a “Caretaker” in their own home to prevent institutionalization. Since SSI is a federal program, this report does not show data pertaining to the SSI money payment. Both SSI and SS recipients are defined as “categorically needy” making them eligible for Medicaid.
